

FuturArc Prize 2023 Awards International Winners and Merit Recipients



Following hundreds of submissions from all over the globe, the international Green design competition **FuturArc Prize 2023** has awarded its Winners and Merit recipients across [various countries](#) throughout May–June 2023.

This cycle's competition theme, **Cross-Generational Architecture**, prompted entrants to explore the rapid change of societal compositions throughout Asia. Entrants were asked to envision sustainable design solutions for future generations amidst ongoing climate and planetary challenges.

From October 2022–February 2023, the competition has attracted participation from over 350 architecture professionals and students. The jury panel, comprising Nan Chyuan, Director, FARM (Singapore); Dr Miya Irawati, Architect and Urban Planner (Indonesia); Dr Tan Loke Mun, Principal, DrTanLM Architect (Malaysia); Quang Vu Linh, Managing Director, ARDOR Green (Vietnam), held a rigorous evaluation process throughout March 2023 to award the 11 teams as follows.
